

Dear Friends,

Jesus is calling you! If you are a Christian, already the Holy Spirit has empowered you to transform the world in all of life: family, work, family, community, world and the gathering of believers! Identifying your spiritual gifts is one of the most helpful keys to understanding what Jesus is calling you to be and to do. Completing an inventory can be a significant step in uncovering your unique combination of spiritual gifts and therefore how you can best serve Jesus and others in all of life.

If taking an inventory is new to you, you may feel one or more of the following:

- **Discomfort:** You may wonder what the results will indicate.
- **Guilt:** You might think that your scores should be higher, or that you have too many low scores.
- **Inferiority:** You may think your scores will not compare favorably with others.

In spite of these feelings, rest assured! These feelings are normal, and the inventory will identify potential spiritual gifts for everyone who takes it. First, remember the questionnaire is designed so that some of your scores will be higher, and some or even many of your scores will be lower. Second, everyone has a few scriptural spiritual gifts. No one has all or many of the gifts. Third, because your mix of gifts is unique, your results will be completely different than every other person's results. This is also by design. Fourth, no gift is more important than any other gift. All gifts are needed!

Discovering your spiritual gifts can be a process, taking some time, even a few years. Inventories are one helpful tool for beginning and facilitating this process. The best way to identify your gifts is to experiment with opportunities where you will serve, USING your gifts. Relax and have FUN! Discovering your gifts is energizing and exciting!
